As part of a larger branding platform for Taqueria del Sol, its website extends the warm and friendly experience of dining there to desktop and mobile browsers.

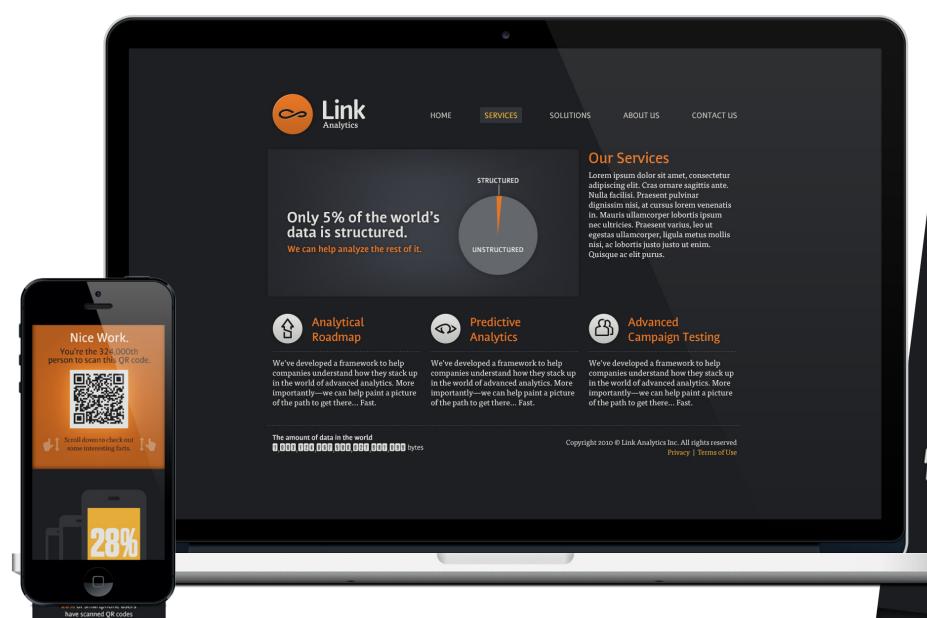

The desktop site highlights the vivid experienes of the High's visiting exhibits with full-screen photography.

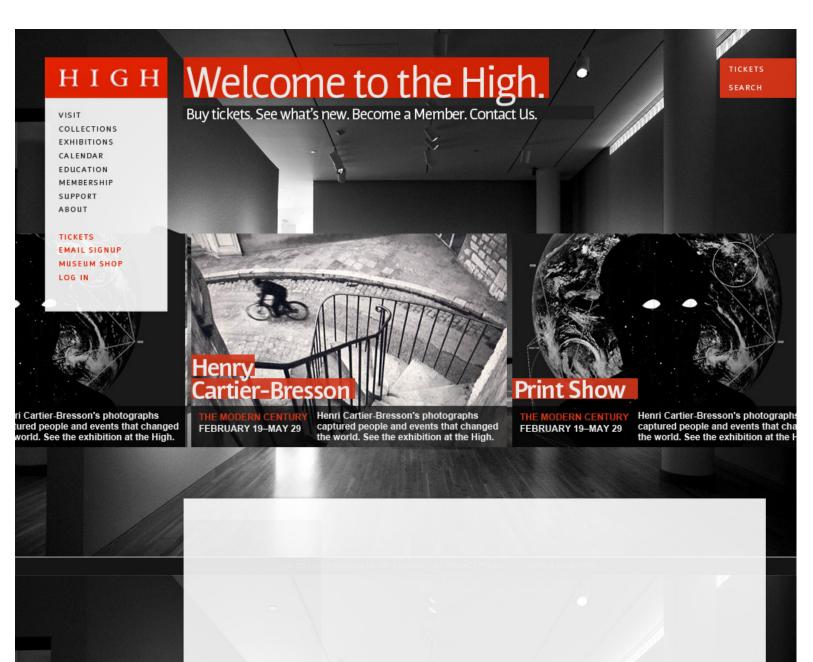
